Dear Hon. Bill Morneau,

I am contacting you on behalf of the Canadian Automatic Merchandising Association (CAMA), a national not-for-profit association representing the national interests of the unattended retailers of food and beverage. We are requesting that the Government support changes to the qualification process of the financial aid programs. We feel that more clarity and flexibility is required to ensure that this is a fair and equitable process. Following are the three main concerns expressed by our membership.

- 1. Will there be any flexibility when calculating the 30% decline in revenue?**
- 2. Will there be flexibility with the retrospective nature of any reference period?**
- 3. The interaction with the CERB is confusing and may restrict employers' ability to re-hire – see page 2 of the attached PDF.**
